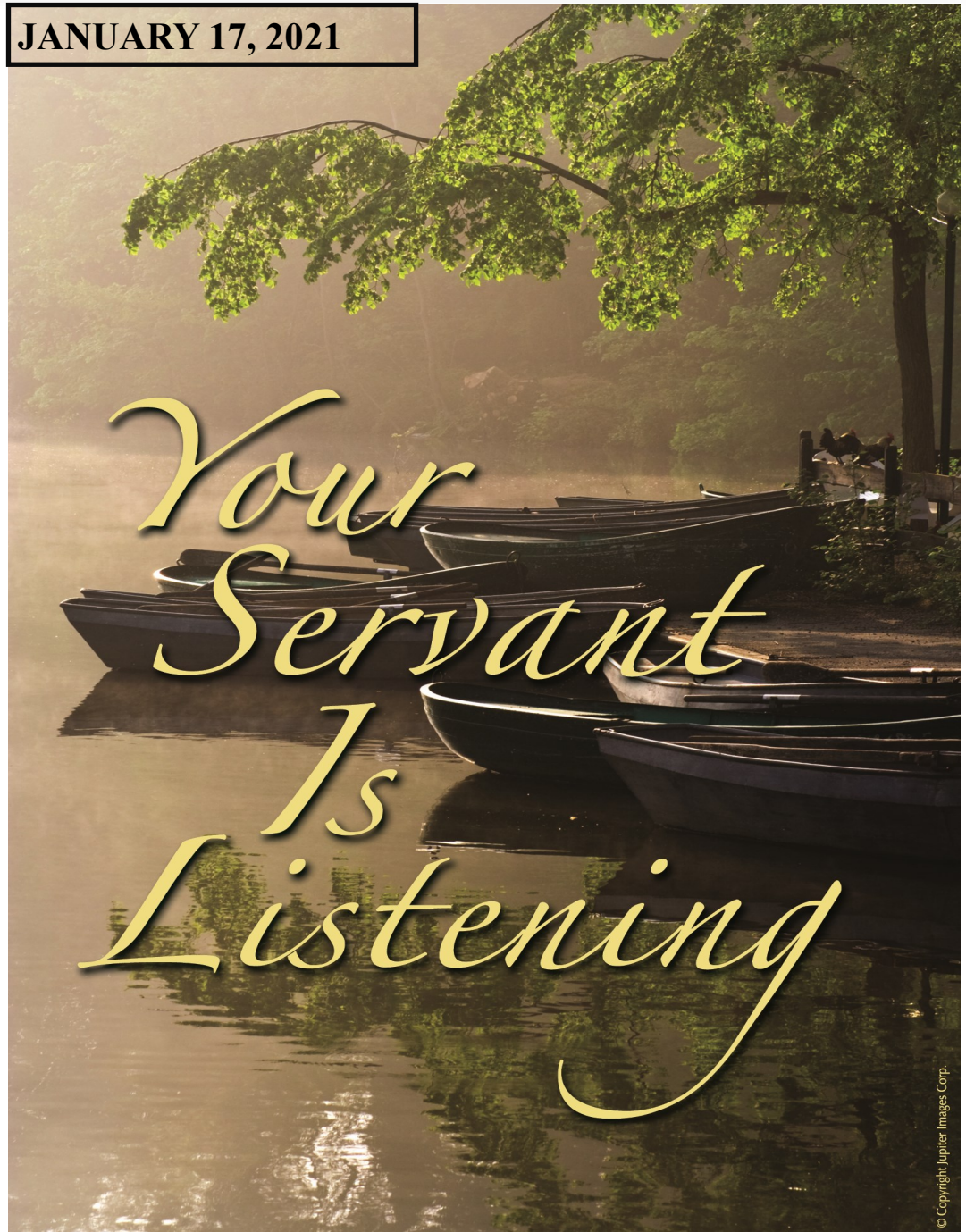

Dear St. Martin of Tours Family and Friends,

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God."

— *Philippians 4:6.*
