

Pastor's Pen



Dear St. Martin of Tours Family and Friends,

Twenty-three years ago, in my silly zeal, I gave up both meat and fish for Lent. That was a terrible mistake! The vast quantity of eggs and instant risotto I was eating caused me to gain weight, lose energy, and I was inordinately grumpy. I was not so much awaiting the Easter celebration as I was anticipating steak and salmon. This kind of "zeal" is the kind of zeal we all could do without!

Another year I gave up coffee. My mood was so altered that friends of mine thought I was having a major depressive episode (which I was not!). Also not a good strategy!

Another year, I decided to be more wise for Lent. When I told a good friend of mine, a Catholic philosopher, what I was up to, he cringed in response: "How can you achieve a virtue of this sort for Lent without becoming a Semi-Pelagian?" (Without going into detail, Semi-Pelagianism is the heresy that claims we acquire God's grace by initiating the process ourselves — which isn't possible of course.) That Lent instead of getting wiser, I remained just as I was: not so wise.

Which is why my penance for this year is what my penance usually is: To find a greater balance within through a moderation in things in which I tend to indulge, the most common being food late at night (especially if someone gives me something premade — usually irresistible!), and a tendency to yield too much attention to things which in the grand scheme of life are not very important. Both have helped me to feel much lighter in spirit! I'm happier and more grateful because of it.

The Catholic Church has in point of fact always preached a discipline of moderation when it comes to the use of *licit* created goods (we don't ever allow for a moderation of sin!), so that the human spirit can be set free to love *without moderation* but with utmost zeal! A Lenten penance indeed ought to cause the flesh to gently quiet itself, so the spirit can rise to its true purpose: Praise of Almighty God and love of neighbor.






