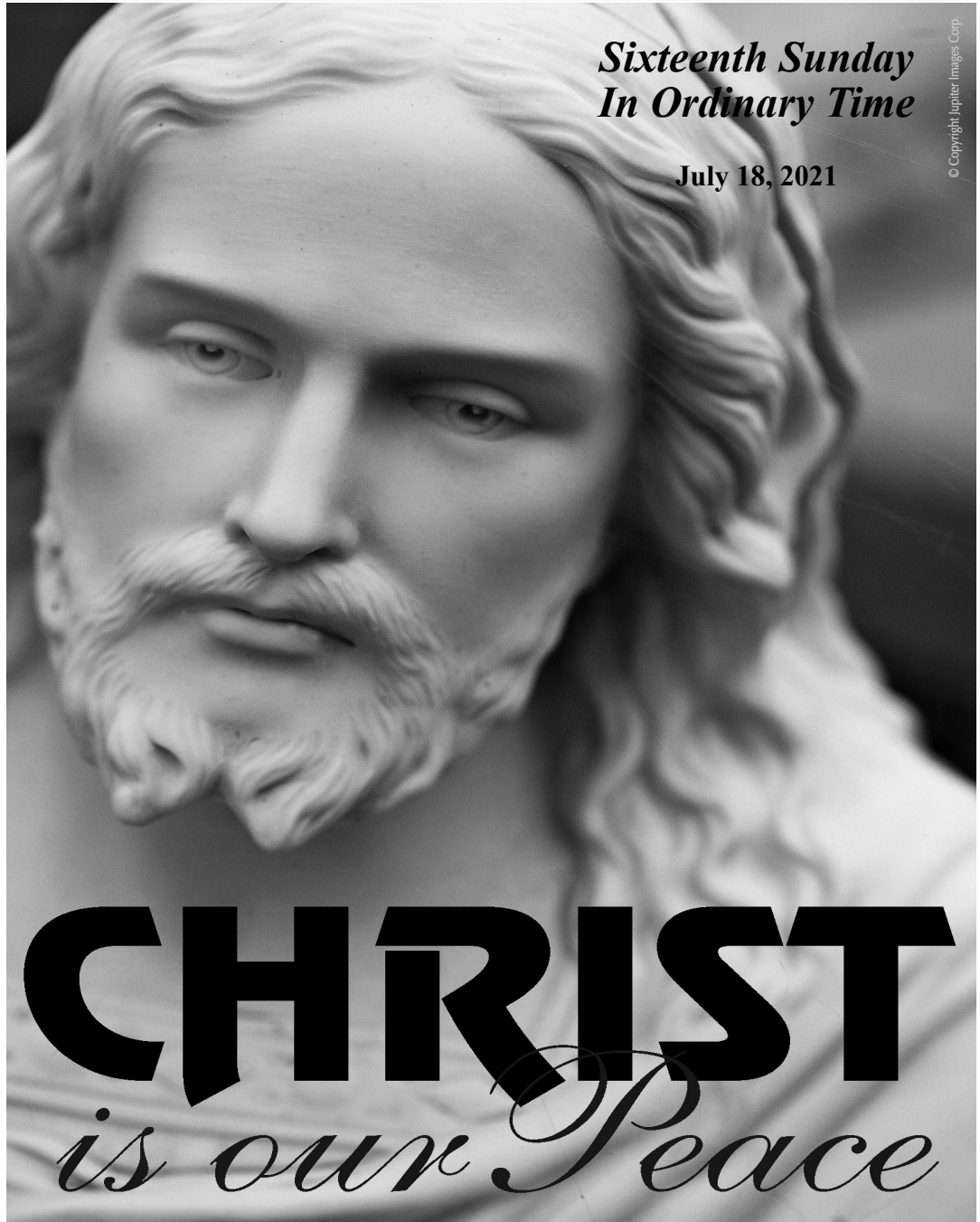

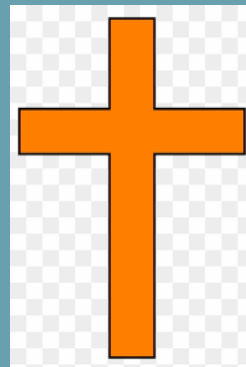
## SUMMER EVENING OF RECOLLECTION FOR WOMEN OF ALL AGES
