

THE "SECOND WIND"

In What's Wrong with the World, G.K. Chesterton writes about "the principle of the second wind". In everything we do that is worthwhile there comes a point where the effort seems too demanding. We need a 'second wind' in order to survive that moment of discouragement. "The joy of battle," he writes, "comes after the first fear of death; the joy of reading Virgil comes after the bore of learning him; the glow of the sea-bather comes after the icy shock of the sea bath; and the success of the marriage comes after the failure of the honeymoon. All human vows, laws, and contracts are so many ways of surviving with success this breaking point, this instant of potential surrender." The second thanks often requires a second wind.

PREVENT & PROTECT STL (formerly known as Protecting God's Children Safe Environment)

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees, and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system before December 31, 2020. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. However, all clergy, volunteers, and employees NEED to register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated code of Ethical Conduct.
