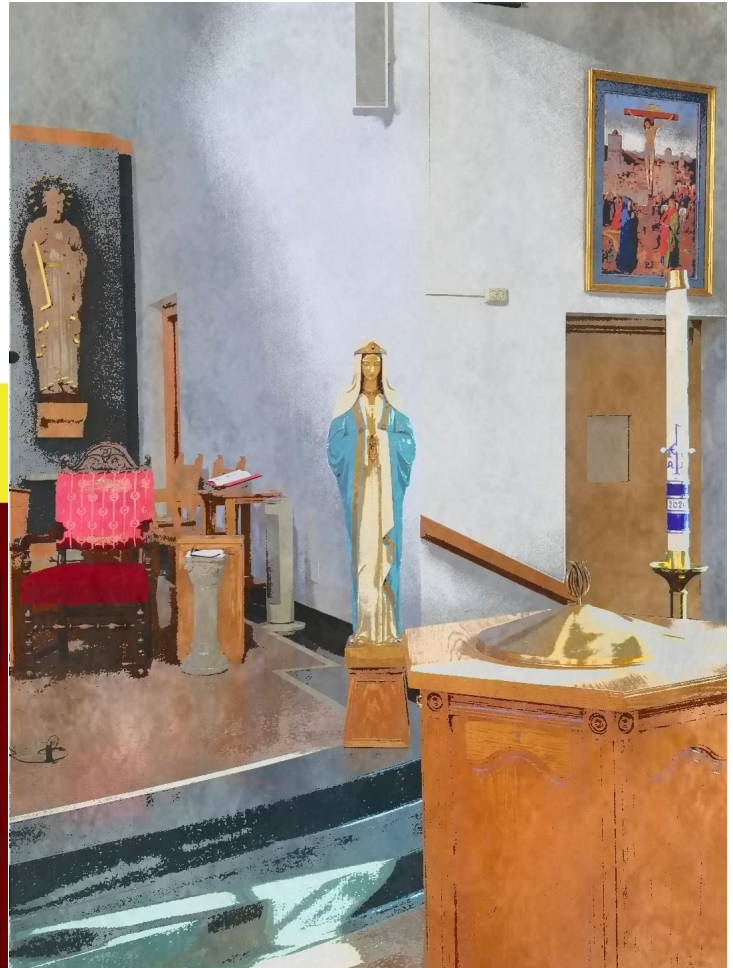
Rosary Novena for Peace
