



One of the best new volunteer opportunities in south county: FAITH Alive in the Home

"Faith Alive In The Home" (FAITH) reaches parents of young toddlers in their own homes, to encourage parents' spiritual growth and to support them in their desire to be the first teachers of the faith for their children. Through a personal relationship with young parents, FAITH home visitors (called FAITH Facilitators) reinforce family connections to the Church community. In each monthly visit, tailored to meet the particular faith goals of each Family, FAITH facilitators model developmentally appropriate activities that parents can then practice with their children.

They can also share simple rituals and practices proven to instill faith and prayer in the home.

FAITH provides resources and advice to assist parents in preparing their child for school readiness as well as spiritual and moral growth. Supporting parents in parenting challenges, FAITH visitors offer methods for virtue-based formation and restorative practices in the family.

Especially if you have experience teaching young children, I strongly urge you to get involved in FAITH. My friend Fr. Nick Winker started this program in North County at St. Ann's Catholic Church, and it's quickly becoming one of the most effective evangelization programs in the Archdiocese.

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

PREVENT & PROTECT STL

(formerly known as Protecting God's Children Safe Environment)

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called **Prevent and Protect STL**

Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees, and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system before December 31, 2020. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service.

Even for those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop:

All clergy, volunteers, and employees <u>*MUST register*</u> for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated code of Ethical Conduct.
