Cast anything that should not be in ...N...Root out any unhealthy and abnormal cells. Open any blocked arteries or veins and rebuild and replenish any damaged areas.

Remove all inflammation and cleanse any infection by the power of Jesus' precious blood.

Let the fire of your healing love pass through ...N's... entire body to heal and make new any diseased areas so that it

will function the way you created it to function.

Touch also ...N's... mind, emotions, even the deepest recesses of (his/her) heart.

Saturate ...N's... entire being with your presence, love, joy, and peace and draw (him/her) ever closer to you every moment of (him/her) life.

And Father, fill $\dots N$ with your Holy Spirit and empower (him/her) to do your works so that (his/her) life will bring glory and honor to your holy name. I ask this in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.
