

# Pastor's Pen



Dear St. Martin of Tours Family,

Janus, the Roman god after which the month of January is names, is ascribed the title "god of thresholds," or "god of entrances and exits," or "god of new beginnings." He's associated with transitions of all sorts, from the very common and repeatable, such as entering or exiting a house, to the rare and singular, such as marks the arrival of a child, a move to a new place, or one's reluctant entrance into middle age.

I particularly like this Roman image. One side represents youth, the other maturity. One would think, therefore that the only motion suggested is from left to right. Yet this is not so! A new endeavor, something exciting, something you ought to have done many years ago, when we embrace movement from darkness to light, from the familiar to the new, we are actually moving from death to life, from a state of wakeful slumber to a place of renewed purpose and rekindled wonder and a new energy.





New Year's resolutions rarely work because one does not acquire virtue "in a vacuum." In other words, you won't change your habits *unless* you also inject something new into your routine, and it has to be something that you *want* to do (not something you ought to do).

What ought I do that will bring me to a new place of interest? I suggest to pray in

the New Year with us. We will be having perpetual Eucharistic Adoration until 3 p.m. Friday January 1. Ask Jesus. He will reveal his desires for you.

Janus can be something of a trickster in Roman mythology, misleading souls down paths that lead only to dead ends. Yet Jesus is not a trickster! He is God who "can neither deceive nor be deceived," as my novice mater used to tell me. He has our best interest in mind. "Ask and you shall receive." And we pray 2021 will be for each of you (and for yours truly!) a year of blessings and of new and holy endeavors.


