

PREVENT AND PROTECT STL


If you are a volunteer of ANY kind or an employee at St. Martin of Tours and are not yet registered in the new system for Protecting God's Children, please do so ASAP.

Enter the passcode (stlprotect) when prompted. Please complete All of the modules to be approved.


