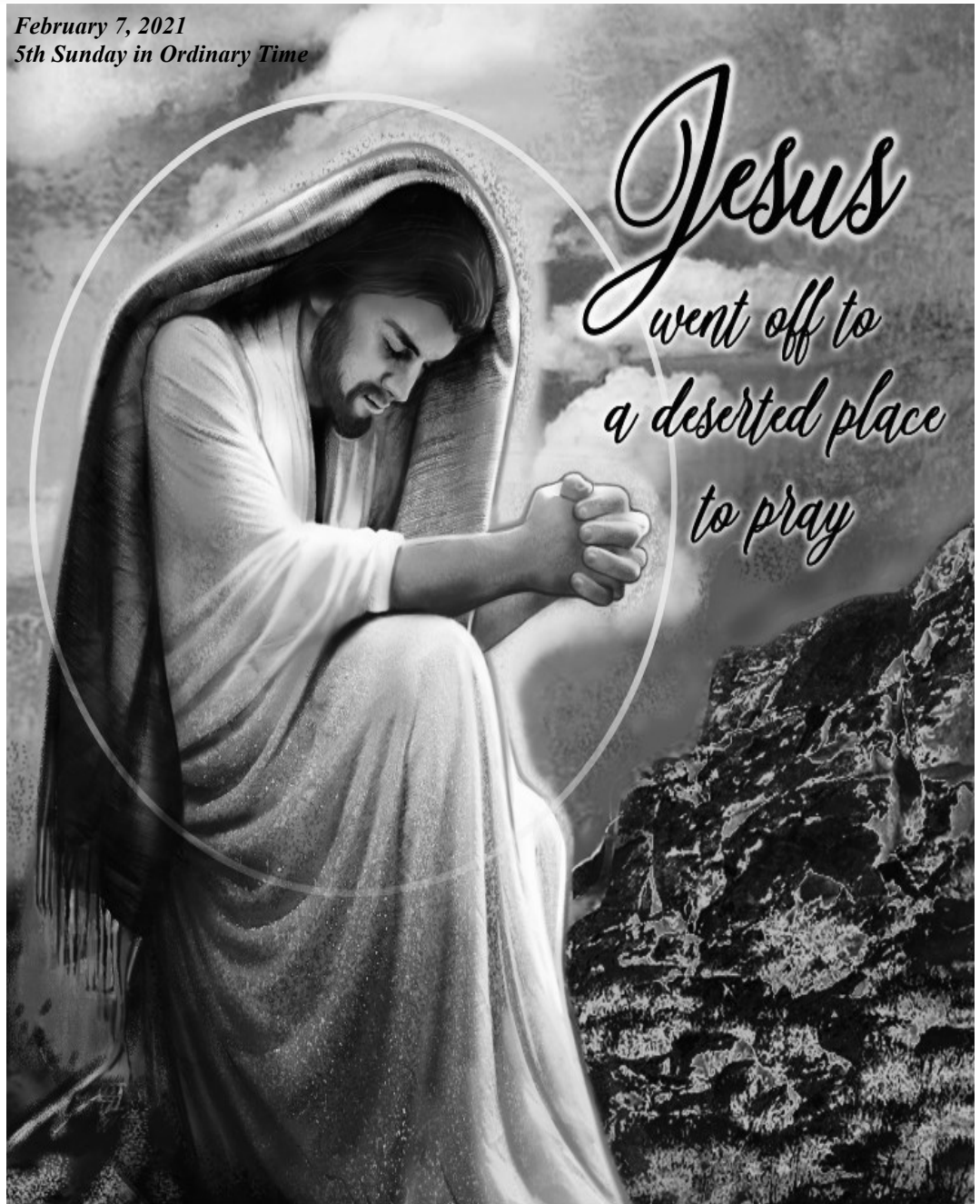

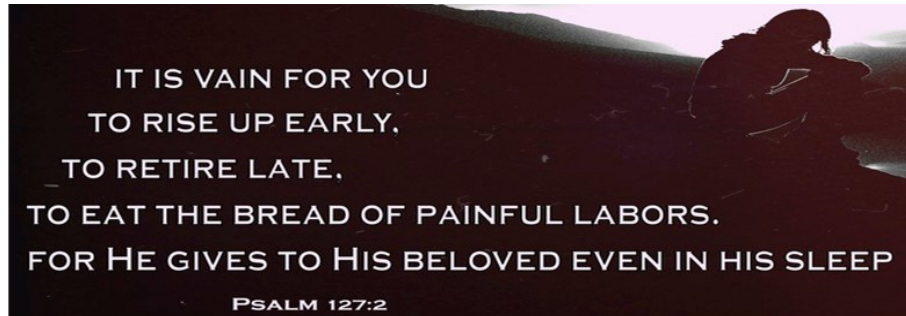

Pastor's Pen



Dear St. Martin of Tours Parishioners,

THE PASSING INTO ETERNITY of a beloved parishioner can be excruciatingly painful in a parish as tight-knit as ours. I have (in consult with the Parish Council) decided on the following new policy: As of January 30, 2021, St. Martin of Tours Parish will use *Constant Contact* (an email service) to inform all of you, as soon as is practicable, of the death of a parishioner and of all arrangements. If you have email yet have not been receiving our *Constant Contacts* please let the office know so that we can enter your email into the data base. If you do not have email, ask a parish friend who has email to keep you informed.

PRAYERS FOR THE SICK. Also: It is time to reinstate the *SICK LIST* we once had in the Parish Bulletin. The old sick list, as you recall, had some people on it for years (understandable since who with a chronic condition wouldn't want prayers of healing?). However, in order to communicate with greater transparency, we are going to divide our *SICK LIST 2.0* into these four sections: PART 1: *FOR THOSE ON HOSPICE*. PART 2: *FOR THOSE IN TREATMENT FOR SERIOUS ILLNESS*. PART 3: *FOR THOSE IN REHAB*. PART 4: *FOR THOSE WITH CHRONIC CONDITIONS*. Since we are essentially starting from scratch with this 4-part list, I ask that as soon as possible you phone to rectory to place yourself or a loved one on the list (See *Dash's Den* for instructions), and also that you specify which of the four categories best suits the one needing prayers.



MONDAY MASS. For the sake of my sanity, I have decided to take Mondays off. Fr. Peter Schavitz, CSSR, will be saying Mass every Monday at 8 a.m. I have known Fr. Schavitz since meeting him at QAS on a Parish Mission. I know him to be a holy priest and an excellent homilist. So, on Mondays, Dash and I will obey the dictum of Psalm 127, verse 2.

You will then be prompted to submit information for a background screening, register for a Protecting God's Children workshop, view two online training modules, and agree to the Code of Ethical Conduct.

*If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop.

You may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.
