

PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

Today we enter the Church's most solemn celebrations of our Catholic Faith — Christ's Paschal Mystery — in Holy Week as well as the Octave of Easter.

Most people know Holy Week is a time of intense devotion for Catholics, but many may not understand that though these days are certainly sacred, so too are the following eight days — the solemn Octave Days of Easter.

During the Octave, we must recall the wondrous revelation of the Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus, as presented in all four Gospels.

I strongly encourage you also to make these days a time of continued devotion after your observance of Lent and Holy Week.

These two weeks are so important to us that even celebrations of any other festivals of the Saints that would fall in the normal liturgical calendar must be passed over.

This means that the celebrations of two of our local patrons — St. Bernadette (April 18) and St. Mark (April 25) — will not be publicly observed this year, but I include two prayers you might use on those days in your private prayer, seeking their intercession.

It is also important that I remind everyone of the three special collections to be taken up in the coming days:

- On Holy Thursday, for Catholic Relief Services and their work in our name to show our support for those in crisis situations.
- On Good Friday, for the Catholic Church in the Holy Land, which is suffering a time of great upheaval.
- On Easter Sunday, for the *Retired Priests* of the Archdiocese of St. Louis, who have diligently served us throughout their lives.

I thank you for your continued charitable support of the Church's mission and wish you God's grace in Holy Week and Easter Season!

PRAYER FOR THE INTERCESSION OF SAINT BERNADETTE

O God,

You chose Bernadette Soubirous to be a humble witness to Your Love and the Power of Your Grace in the apparitions she received at Lourdes.
