

PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

For a second week in a row, Archbishop Rozanski has written to inform me that one of my requests for an Annual Catholic Appeal Emergency Grant has been approved.

This *ACA Emergency Grant* is distinct from last week's report of the two Ensuring Parish Viability Grants given to each of our parishes.

Recipients of the ACA Emergency Grants are parishes that have significant structural repair needs that could not be addressed solely with weekly parish revenues alone.

The ACA Grants are also based on each individual parish's history of successful participation in the Annual Catholic Appeal.

My request during early March noted thus far in fiscal year 2025 (July 2024-February 2025) St. Mark needed repairs to our four parish sites (Sts. Mark, Andrew, Matthias, & Bernadette) which cost \$400,564.

St. Mark's participation in the 2024 ACA Campaign was outstanding, with its Published Goal of \$44,298 which was nearly doubled in actual contributions of \$82,402.

The Archbishop's Annual Catholic Appeal Grant to St. Mark Parish is \$30,000.

With this ACA Emergency Grant added to last week's reported Ensuring Parish Viability Grant St. Mark parish will receive \$55,000 from the Archdiocese for its substantial needs.

I am always edified by the generosity of all our parishioners, but as we find ourselves the recipient of yet another Archdiocesan grant, we should be grateful also to the Archdiocese in recognizing our very real need in this way.

I do hope that our parishes appreciate how important the *Annual Catholic Appeal* is and will be most responsive to the call to participate in the upcoming Campaign in late April.


