

Recently highly questionable complaints which allege abuse by Fr. Bob Reiker, (former pastor of St. Bernadette, now retired to St. Justin the Martyr Parish) have been raised in a lawsuit against the Archdiocese of St. Louis.

Father Bob categorically denies the accusations.

Nonetheless, though he enjoys the presumption of innocence, Archbishop Rozanski has asked that he refrain from public ministry until there is more clarity concerning these nameless claims asserted in the lawsuit.

Our Archdiocese is committed to examining each claim individually in a search for the truth so that justice may be served for all involved.


The Knights of Columbus 742 Ladies Auxiliary are grateful for all the support shown to our School
