Our excellent maintenance staff is led by Jeff Boeger, with the full support of Bridget Gabel, and Avelino Bautista.




The technical needs as well as the scheduling of our athletic facilities are most ably supplied by an outstanding volunteer, Peter Soderquist.

OUR SAINT LOUIS ARCHDIOCESE HAS THREE SAINTLY PATRONS

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has three patron saints:

- Louis IX, king of France,
- Vincent DePaul, founder of the Congregation of the Mission and Daughters of Charity,
- Rose Philippine Duchesne, Religious of the Sacred Heart and frontier missionary.

We are blessed by the example of these three holy lives:

- a layman, called by Christ to serve as a ruler, a husband and a faithful witness.
- a priest, called by Christ to serve by proclaiming the charity that should all people.
- and a consecrated religious, called by Christ to offer her life as a frontier teacher.

All three came from France, though from different times with different challenges:

- Louis (1214-1270) reigned as King of France from 1235 until his death while on crusade in Tunisia and is remembered as an outstandingly just, pious, and faithful ruler—a faithful spouse, and loving father.
- Vincent DePaul (1581-1660) served as a chaplain to a wealthy family, and used their resources to offer missions to evangelize the French peasantry, founding two religious congregations, the Vincentians and the Daughters of Charity.
- **Rose Philippine Duchesne (1769-1852)** dreamed of becoming a missionary to the Native Peoples of America, and eventually as a Religious of the Sacred Heart came to the Archdiocese of St. Louis to found the first Catholic schools on the American frontier.

Each of these patron saints, though separated from us by time, share in their example that each of us with a distinct calling, is summoned to center our lives on making Christ's Presence the foundation of our own lives of faith, and then making his love felt through the use of our own dreams, talents, and inspirations in obedience to his Holy Will.
