



## PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE A Guided Scripture Study

Several months ago I was asked to initiate a guided study in the Holy Scriptures—something that has always been a passion of mine.

In doing this in the past, I faced questions of the scope and timing of such Adult Studies.

Some communities asked for general lessons on the Old and New Testaments, others for instruction in individual books of the Bible.

What I initially propose, in this instance, is a weekly study in the Scriptures proclaimed in the Mass of the following Lenten Sunday.

Experience has taught me what is most beneficial in offering the riches of Biblical Revelation can be two one-hour meetings, held on the same day—one session in the afternoon and another in the evening—which thereby broadens the availability of participation by as many folks as possible.

Beginning on March 4th, I will offer this Guided Study in the Sunday Scriptures in the Pastoral Office Meeting Room (4200 Ripa Ave.) at 1 PM and then again at 7 PM.

I hope this will prove to be an opportunity for prayerful informed instruction, open discussion, and thoughtful application of the Word of God for all who may choose to participate.




