FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

Two more current questions answered:—

Why do we publish a single weekly "Pastoral" Bulletin rather than two separate "Parish" Bulletins?

As noted in my original letter to all parishioners, one of the positive and practical outcomes of the past year is that members of the former five Catholic parishes have begun to support activities held at either St. Mark or St. Martin Parishes.

All organizations are open to new members from any community.

So the "Pastoral" Bulletin addresses the full gamut of opportunities for all the Faithful.

When will St. Martin parishioners receive their own Sunday contribution envelopes?

Immediately following the Vatican's decision that I would serve as pastor of the two parishes, our staff began to work on separating the contribution envelopes so one set would be marked for St. Martin and the other for St. Mark.

Before Sunday, July 7th, Our Sunday Visitor Publishers should have mailed the July 2024 contribution packets marked for St. Martin to registered parishioners of St. Martin.

Nonetheless, by the end of June, parishioners from both parishes will also receive contribution envelopes marked as St. Mark for July.


