Jesus calls each of us in this holy season to draw closer to Him, and to distance ourselves from what separates us from Him and one another.

I found this bit of Lenten advice in this regard:

During this Lent:

"Try Fasting from Criticism and Feasting on Praise.

"Try Fasting from Self-Pity and Feasting on Gratitude.

"Try Fasting from Ill-Temper and Feasting on Peace.

"Try Fasting from Jealousy and Feasting on Love.

"Try Fasting from Resentment — and Feasting on Contentment.

"Try Fasting from Pride and Feasting on Humility.

"Try Fasting from Selfishness and Feasting on Service.

"Try Fasting from Fear and Feasting on Faith.

I find this to be a more productive expansion from seeing Lent as only a time of negative selfdenial, by urging us to follow a more positive path of spiritual growth.

- All Catholics from the age of 14 are required to abstain from the consumption of meat on Ash Wednesday and all Lenten Fridays.
