

THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

November is filled with several liturgical feasts of importance to our local Catholic Community.

Tomorrow, November 11th, we will celebrate the festival of St. Martin of Tours.

As is our custom, when the feast of one of the five local patron saints who are part of our area's Catholic heritage arises, we all gather at the church of that Saint.

Tomorrow a single celebration of Holy Mass will be concelebrated by the parish priests at 8:00 AM in St. Martin Church on Telegraph Road — there will be no other Masses that day.

The same will be true at the end of this month when we will gather in memory of the First Called of the Apostles, **St. Andrew**, on **November 30th** for the celebration of Holy Mass at his Church on Hoffmeister Avenue.

Also on Thanksgiving Day, November 28th, we will gather in St. Martin's Church at 9:00 AM for Mass.

For civil holidays, as is our custom, we rotate the celebration of a single Mass back and forth between the Churches of St. Mark and St. Martin.

As you may have heard, the American Catholic Bishops have changed their policy with regard to our Nation's patronal feast, the Immaculate Conception.

Whereas their previous policy for when this feast fell on a Sunday of Advent was to move the celebration to the following Monday but not the obligation to attend Holy Mass.

In their wisdom that policy has been abrogated and Monday, December 9th, the celebration of our **Mother Mary's Conception** is a Holy Day of Obligation — our Mass schedule will be identical to the Solemnity of All Saints.

SAINT MARTIN OF TOURS NOVEMBER 11TH

Saint Martin of Tours, born into a pagan family in what is now Hungary around 316, was raised in Italy where his father was posted as a tribune.

When he was compelled to enter the Roman military, a popular legend says that while on campaign the saint cut his cloak in half to share with a cold beggar.

That night Martin dreamed of the beggar who was transformed into Jesus who told him before he was even baptized he had come to understand baptism.

He was baptized, and was released from the military when he refused battle pay and said he chose to fight as a soldier for Christ.


Martin is one of the first recognized conscientious objector.

In 371 he was reluctantly made bishop of the city of Tours, France.

In 397, when Martin died, he was honored as the first saint of the Western Church who was not a martyr.

Martin is the Patron Saint of soldiers and wine producers, and the country of France.

Deficience parish census – timeline –

—**This Weekend:** Following the Liturgy of the Word at each Mass, folks will be asked to complete a new Registration Form for their household, returning it either immediately in the collection basket or at some later Sunday or at the Pastoral Office.

— Until the End of November: Copies of the Census Form will be available in each Church for anyone who may not have been with us this week.

They will be able to return the Form in the churches; in the collection basket or at the Pastoral Office.

—In December: A mailing will offer the same form to any parishioners from each of the five formerly separate parishes who were unable to participate in the initial November effort.

—In January: Another mailing will be sent to encourage anyone yet to respond to do so by the end of February when anyone who has chosen not to register will be placed on the list of inactive parishioners.


