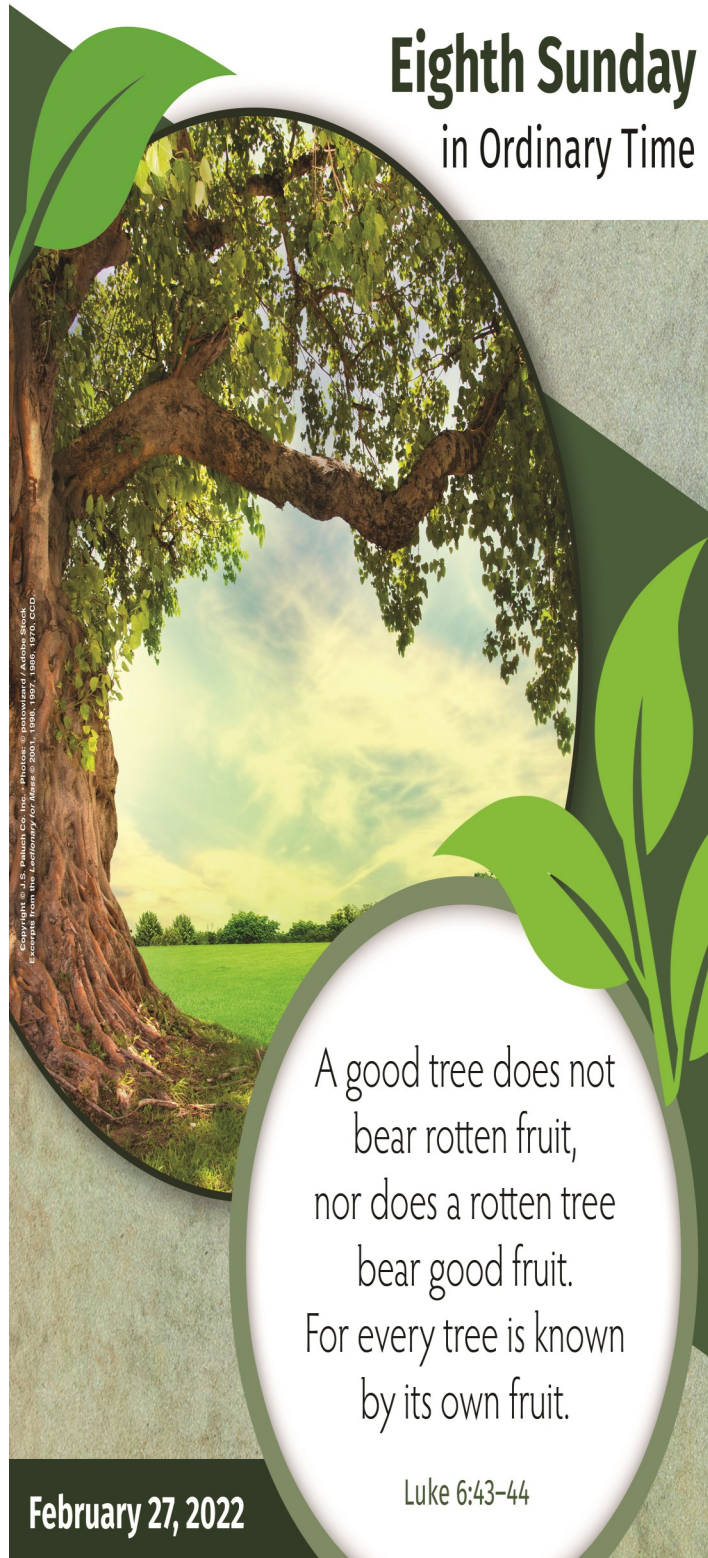

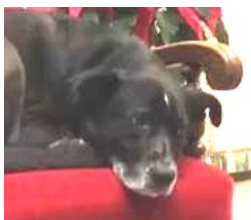
THE WEARING OF THE GREEN & CORNED BEEF N' CABBAGE MARCH 9th LUNCH MEETING
