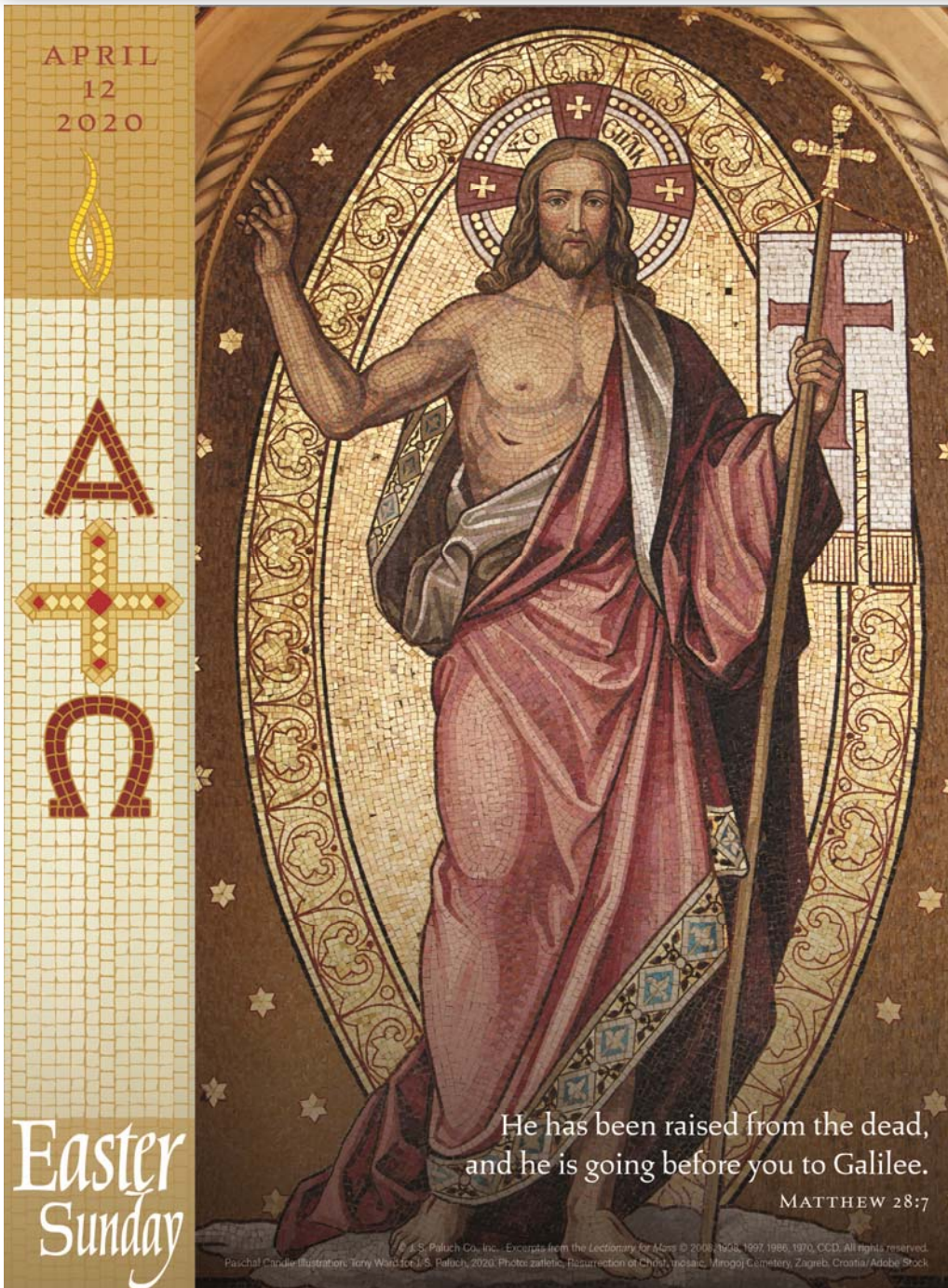

WHAT IS CANCELED ANYWAY?

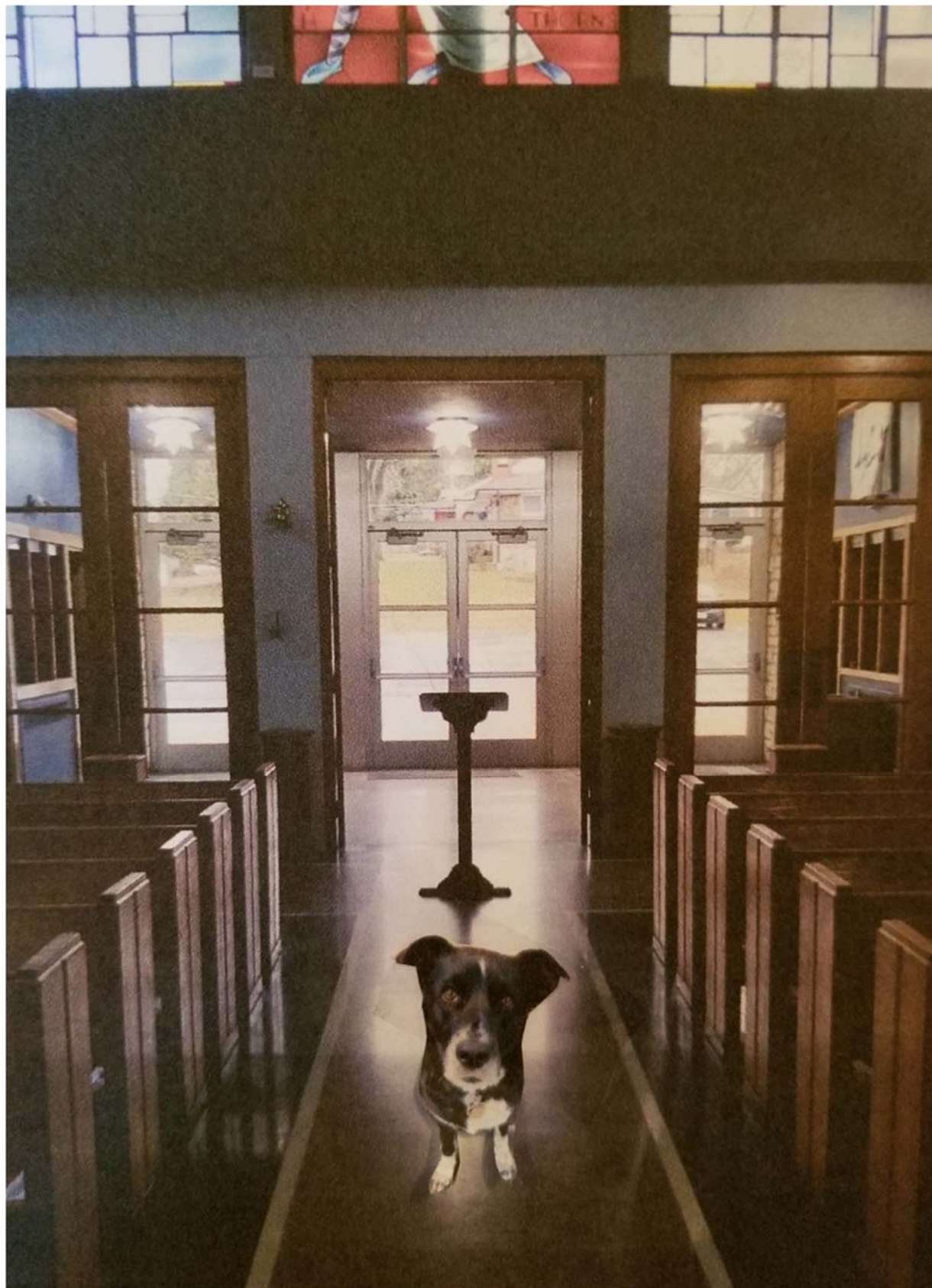
For the foreseeable future, probably well past Easter and into late April, all the following are canceled:
