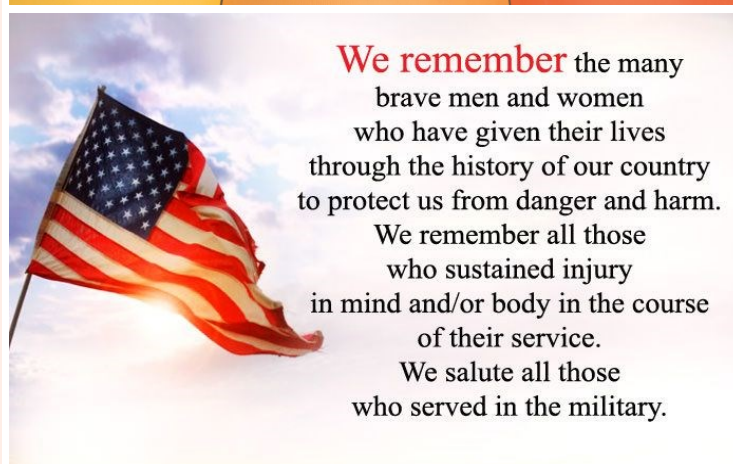
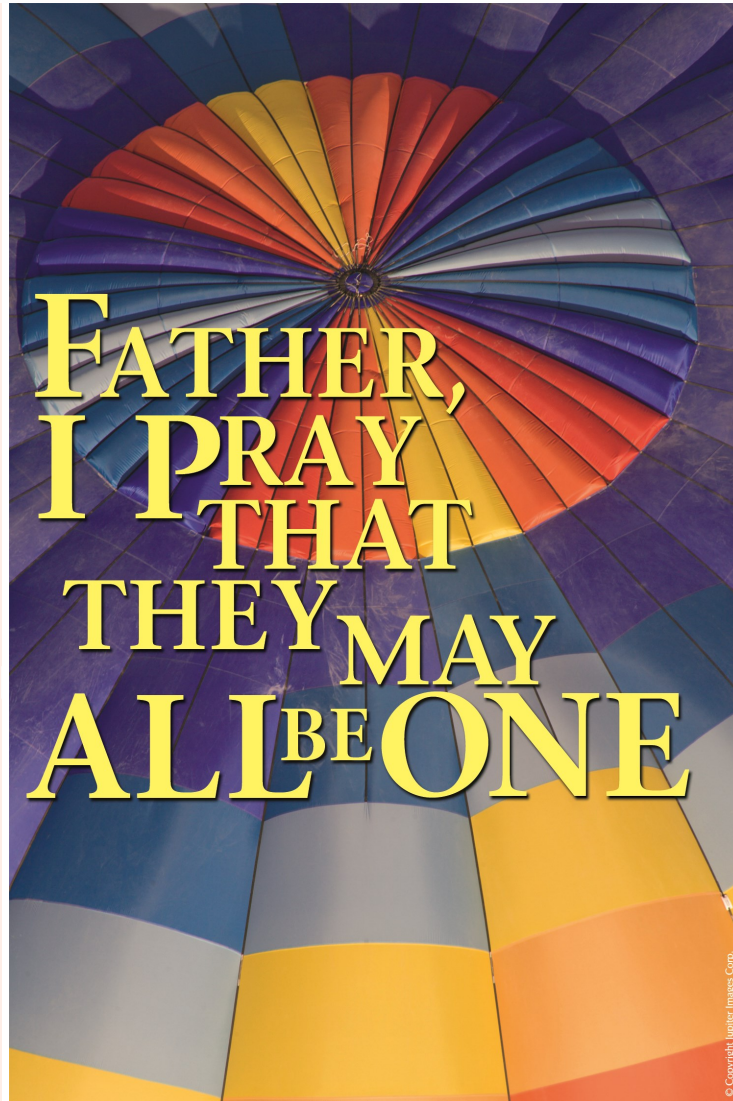

# Pastor's Pen



Dear St. Martin of Tours Family and Friends,

*He has made everything beautiful in its time.  
He has also set eternity in the human heart;  
yet no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end.  
- Ecclesiastes 3:11*

I have come to the strangest of conclusions. Somehow, God can multiply time, not unlike the way he multiplied loaves and fish.
