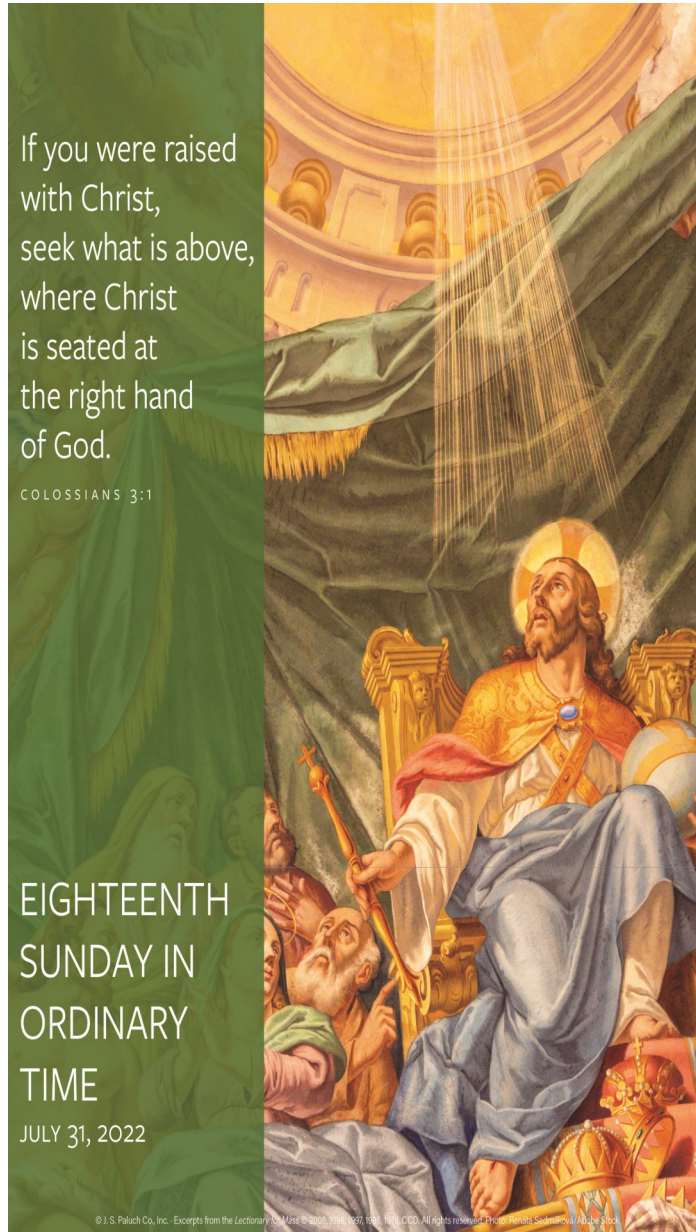

To ensure social distancing, please make an appointment by calling **314-251-GIVE (4483)** or online at **MercyBlood-Donor.net**

All donors will be required to bring a state-issued form of ID. Masks must be worn during the donation period. If you have received a vaccine, please be aware of which one you have received, and when it was last administered.

Do not donate blood if in the past 10 days you have tested positive or have symptoms of COVID-19, or if you have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19. Whether or not you have been vaccinated, as long as you do not have COVID or symptoms of COVID you are eligible to give blood, and under the usual conditions.
