





Altar of the Holy Face



Official reproduction of the image of the Holy Face as it is venerated in the Shrine at Tours, France

*First class relic of St. Louis IX, King of France (1226-1270)
The relic contains a lock of his hair*

First class relic of St. Martin of Tours, Bishop (316-397)

The special scapular revealed to French mystic & stigmatist Marie-Julie Jahenny (1850-1941) for special protection of persons and places during calamities and chastisements

Many relics including a splinter from the wood of the True Cross, a small piece of Our Lady's veil, and a piece of bone from St. Joseph



St. Martin with the goose that led the people of Tours to his place of hiding, preventing him from avoiding being made bishop by acclamation.

St. Jude Thaddeus, the apostle and patron of impossible causes who healed the King of Edessa with the "Acheiropoiera," the Image-not-made-by-human-hands, which wrapped the face of Jesus at His burial.

Dear St. Martin of Tours Parishioners and Friends,

On the Feast Day of St. Martin of Tours, **Friday, November 11 right after the 8 a.m. Mass** we are going to have a special sacramental celebration of **HEALING** and **RENEWAL** by anointing all who attend with special oil that has been blessed in the presence of the image of the Holy Face of Jesus, which resides at the official shrine of the Holy Face in Tours, France—the very city which is under the special patronage of St. Martin.



St. Martin of Tours himself is regarded as one of the saint protectors of the image of the Holy Face of Jesus, along with St. Louis IX, the King of France.

There have been more healings attributed to the special anointing of the holy oil of the Holy Face of Jesus than any other Catholic devotion or holy site, even more than at Lourdes, France.

In fact, my own involvement with this devotion began when I was first ordained some fifteen years ago, and the sister of one of my parishioners at Saints Joachim and Ann parish in St. Peters was miraculously cured from cancer by being anointed with this oil.

Since all of us are in need of healing—spiritual, mental, emotional, and physical, I want to invite you all to this healing service. You may of course bring others with you. And begin to pray now to receive a great gift of healing.

If you don't have access to a computer, you can still sign up for a Listening Session by phoning the Parish Office at 314-544-5664

The next step in this multi-year process is to hear more robustly from parishioners about their specific parish. The Archdiocese of St. Louis will host over 350 listening sessions throughout our 178 parishes between October 8 - November 19, 2022. Parishioners are invited to register for their parish's listening session beginning today at <https://allthingsnew.archstl.org/Ways-to-Engage/Listening-Sessions>.

If you have specific questions to be raised at these listening sessions please send them to the parish office!

Each listening session will be facilitated by volunteer parishioners from a different parish. These trained facilitators will share pre-recorded messages from Archbishop Rozanski and Fr. Chris Martin, Vicar for Strategic Planning, with an overview of All Things New, a planning area overview and multiple DRAFT model options to consider for the respective planning area. A brief time will be allowed for small group discussion and facilitated large group feedback. If your parish has more than one Listening Session, the information presented at both is the same.

The goals of the listening sessions are to engage as many parishioners as possible in understanding the current state of our parishes and diocese and to solicit feedback from as many parishioners as possible about the DRAFT models options for their planning area.
