

Dear St. Martin of Tours Family,

A bird in the hand is worth two in the bush, unless you can kill two birds with one stone. So here's an idea from the Parish Council to help the poor, and also to evangelize the community. We need *you* for this to work!

"BIRD ONE": Collecting food for the Poor. So, we are looking for volunteers to go door to door to homes in our parish boundary (just for one day, probably a Saturday), to ask for canned or dry goods for our St. Vincent de Paul Society.

Here's the plan:

- 1. Teams of two
- 2. Take a small section of the parish (I'm getting a map prepared)
- 3. Carry St. Vincent de Paul material
- 4. Let's do this just before Thanksgiving (Saturday, November 23rd?)

"BIRD TWO": <u>Evangelization</u>. *If* the person at the door decides to donate, *then* we tell them about our parish, and we would love to have them join us. The plan:

- 1. If they give then we tell them about our parish
- 2. Carry St. Martin of Tours material

Do you see how these two parts work together from a marketing point of view?




White Progressive: \$5,000; Purple: \$1,000 Thank you to workers and players for your support.

Parish Collection for Our Lady's Inn October 19-20 & October 26-27

Since 1982, Our Lady's Inn has served as a life-affirming alternative to abortion for almost 7,000 women and their unborn babies. Case management with individualized services to address personal health, educational, and psychosocial needs is also offered. A case manager, nurse, counselor, child advocate, and other staff support the women and children. Our Aftercare program offers two years of continued support to each family once they have moved out.

Our parish will have baby bottles (collection bottles) available in the vestibule after Masses for this collection starting the weekend of October 19th & 20th. All donations for Our Lady's Inn can be placed inside the bottles and will be collected the weekend of October 26th & 27th after Masses in the vestibule.


