

A heads up about two major repairs.

First, the church boiler. The church boiler is caput, so we are ordering a new one. Fortunately, we can pay off the boiler with our \$100K in our capital improvement account. But because of supply chain issues, there may be a delay in installation. So expect it to be colder in church for a little while.

Second, the roof. We are having a major repair in two weeks which should stop all the leaks and hold us for another season. I'm thinking this will cost us between \$7—10 K.
