SMT Bingo is in need of help. We need volunteers to work as Bingo Callers, Pull Tab Sellers and Call Back Workers.

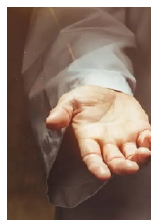
The bingo hall is a non-smoking environment. Some of the spots needed to be filled start at 5 pm.

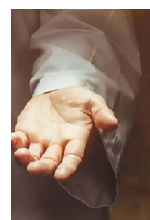
