

EPIPHANY HOUSE BLESSING

If you wish, you can celebrate Epiphany at home with a blessing using the initials of the magi's traditional names (Casper, Melchior, Balthasar), four crosses, and the new year's numerals.

Materials: a piece of chalk.

Gather with family members and friends at the front door.

Leader: In the (+) name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. We sign this doorway with four crosses and the numerals of the new year.

[20 + C + M + B + 25]Let us pray: May Christ bless this house!

ALL: Amen!

Leader: Let us pray as Jesus taught us.

ALL: Our Father, Who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

Leader: Bless this household through all days to come, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, forever and ever.

ALL: Amen.




GIVING TREES SUCCESSFUL AT ST. MARK & ST. MARTIN


