

### CATHOLIC TEACHING ON LABOR

One of the most important principles of Catholic social teaching is the dignity of work and the rights of workers.

Four encyclicals address this foundational social teaching, with the most recent being Saint Pope John Paul's *Centesimus Annus* (1991) addressing both the theology and dignity of human labor.

In Genesis, God calls his human creatures to become the faithful stewards of his entire creation; and thus to share in God's creative love as His partners in bringing His wondrous work to its completion and fulfillment.

From this perspective, work is understood in terms of sharing in God's ongoing activity to build, and transform the world always for the good.

As co-creators - human beings must be self-disciplined to develop and find their true fulfillment in union with God.

By our labor, we shape the world and our environment and also shape ourselves.

Labor Day offers an excellent opportunity to reflect on how we view what we do each day in the light of Catholic social teaching.




