

#### ASSOCIATE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

#### HEALING OF THE FAMILY TREE

Anyone who is interested in genealogy can tell you that family lineages can be fascinating. A number of companies have sprung up, helping to discover details about who have preceded us in our family ancestry. Sometimes people in one's ancestry have done things, the effects of which are handed down through future generations to our present time. The Original Sin of our first parents Adam and Eve is a prime example. The effects of their action, which all future generations have inherited, have caused us to suffer hard working conditions, illnesses and even death. For this the Church provides the Sacrament of Baptism for the relief of the primary effect which is separation from God's sanctifying and sacramental graces.

Ancestors more closely related to us in time may have also participated in actions and even organizations that can bring evil into their lives as well as into our own. Various rituals, membership in certain organizations and dabbling in the occult can all pass on harmful effects down through future generations.

Such things as voodoo, Santeria, spiritualism, both black and white magic, use of amulets and good luck charms, curses, hexes, Tarot cards and Ouija boards, seances, crystals and channeling can all open portals to spirits that are not of the Lord. Personally, or having previous family membership in such groups as Free Masonry/Shriners/the Scottish Rite, Scientology and Rosicrucianism can also have negative influence in one's life. Addictions to alcohol, drugs, food, sex, social media can take hold of one's life and indirectly have harmful effects on one's children and grandchildren. Personal or familial exposure to types of violence: domestic emotional, physical, and/or spiritual abuse can all effect those down the successor line as well.

If you, or any family member, living or deceased, have had any of these characteristics in their own life or among their ancestry, please consider coming to a healing service on Thursday, October 17<sup>th</sup>, 7:00 PM, at St. Mark Church, for prayers for healing of such effects during Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, ending with Benediction. We can also offer prayers for any of your loved ones who have separated from the Church and distanced themselves from Christ's love.






#### VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR LITURGICAL ENVIRONMENT TEAMS


